

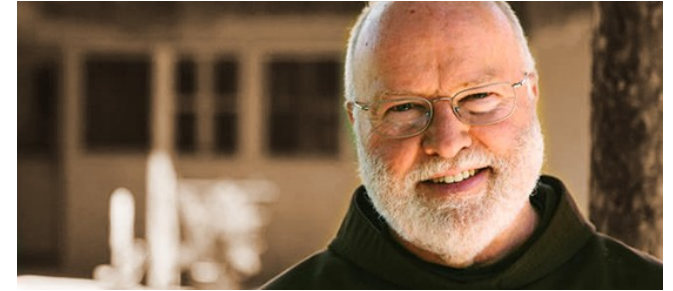
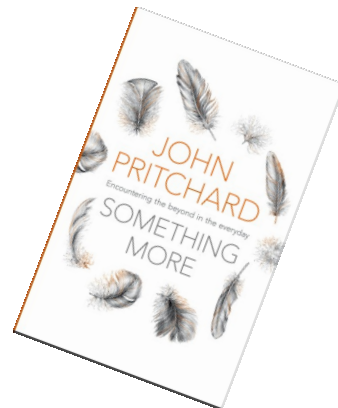


**Something More**

Pritchard was ordained in the Church of England as a priest in 1973. In 2007 he became the 42nd Bishop of Oxford, retiring in 2014.
