



All Saints West Dulwich is delighted to announce that the Bishop of Kingston, on behalf of the Bishop of Southwark, has appointed the Revd Prebendary Dr Alan Everett to the post of Vicar, All Saints West Dulwich, subject to the usual legal formalities.

Alan is currently the Vicar of St Clement Notting Dale and St James Norlands, in which Grenfell Tower is situated. His previous parish was in Hackney—St Michael London Fields—and prior to that he was a university chaplain. He served his curacy outside Wigan, and was trained at Westcott House, Cambridge.

The Grenfell Tower fire, its aftermath and implications for parish ministry are described in his book: *After the Fire: Finding Words for Grenfell*. Alan is also a painter: his most recent solo exhibition of abstract paintings was at St Stephen Walbrook, in the City of London.

Alan is married to Julie, a Consultant Speech and Language Therapist, who works in paediatric deafness at University College Hospital. They have two daughters: Emily who is at Durham University, and Charlotte, who will be taking her A Levels in June.

Alan is very much looking forward to working with the people of All Saints, in the community of West Dulwich.

He will be licensed in July 2019.
